

Camp Warren Jyrch just finished on August 8. This was the 43rd











One consequence of insurance reform is higher out-of-pocket costs. While having access to insurance is paramount, we must find ways to make sure that all insurers understand the burden this could place on our families. This is especially consequential if it is calculated as a percentage of medication costs. BDAI staff and volunteers started a strong advocacy campaign around this topic over the past year and we will continue to carry this message forward.

There is and will always be more we can do for advocacy. Illinois offers strong services and support for our community. Therefore, it might be easy for us to just sit back and rest on our laurels, but this is not wise at all.
